Lifeguard Job Description

The South Burlington Recreation Department is looking for hard working dedicated individuals to serve as lifeguards at our small community beach. Our beach is in Red Rocks Park, South Burlington and over looks Shelburne Bay of Lake Champlain. It provides a great place for the community to go and enjoy the lake.

Lifeguard responsibilities will be to monitor and supervise the beach area to ensure a safe environment for patrons. Duties include responding to swimmers in distress, enforcing beach rules and regulations, administering First Aid and CPR as needed and participation in the cleaning and maintenance of the beach area and facility. Also perform other related duties as assigned.

Candidate must have previous Life guarding experience. Possession of American Red Cross certificates in Life guarding, Standard First Aid and CPR for the Professional Rescuer or equivalent. Must have valid driver's license and reliable transportation. Must submit to a complete criminal history background check. There are full-time and part-time seasonal position from mid June to mid August available.

Salary is based on experience and starts at \$9.00 per hour. Weekly hours are 32 hours. Season is from June 16, 2008 to August 18, 2008 and is made up of; 1 week of mandatory staff training and 8 weeks of Life guarding.
